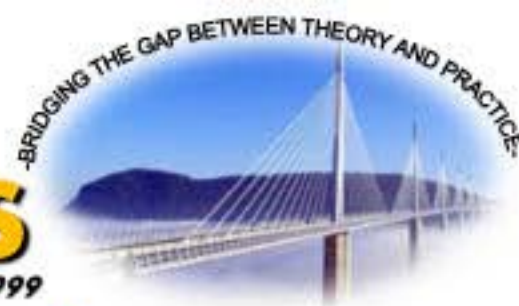
MEMBERSHIP

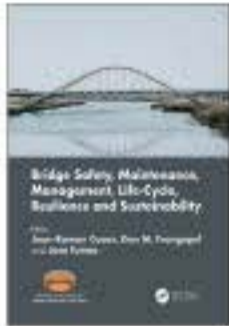

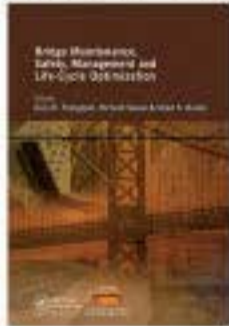

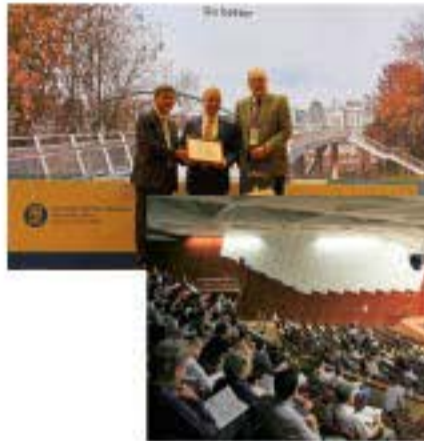
